Island Health and the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) are pleased to inform you of our upcoming Triple P (Positive Parenting Program) training opportunity. Two Group Triple P courses will be offered as per the information below. The two options offered are as follows:

- **Victoria** - Group, September 20 - 22, 2017 (3 days);
Or
- **Qualicum** - Group, September 25 - 27, 2017 (3 days).

Each participant will be required to commit to attending the full course to be considered for registration. Registrations for a half day accreditation will follow on one of these scheduled dates:

- **Victoria** - November 14 or 15, ½ day only (a.m. or p.m.)
- **Qualicum** - November 16 or 17, ½ day only (a.m. or p.m.).

Organizations requesting training spaces will be asked to commit to the points included in the application form attached. Island Health and MCFD are responsible for the following:

- cost of training and accreditation;
- ongoing resources for use by practitioners and families;
- coordinating training and accreditation;
- providing accreditation preparation;
- providing ongoing practitioner support through community meetings, organizational meetings, and/or individual consultations;
- preparation and distribution of a practitioner newsletter.

In addition, please provide a rationale for the practitioner's name you have provided as it relates to the attached **Triple P Training Guiding Principles**.
