

Vancouver Island Triple P Training Guiding Principles

In order to determine eligibility and priority for Triple P training, the following guiding principles will be employed:

Eligibility:

1. Currently employed with a community-based organization that provides parenting support;

and
2. Employed with an organization that has demonstrated an ongoing commitment to the delivery of Triple P services (as evidenced through submission of data and/or ordering of Triple P resources and/or submits information to calendar of Triple P services);

or
3. Organizations that have not previously sent practitioners for training but that can demonstrate commitment by proposing a plan for providing Triple P services;

and
4. Manager and practitioner verbally commit to training and accreditation and sign the Letter of Agreement for training.

Priority:

The Triple P leadership team will assess those eligible for training to achieve a balance of agency capacity and client access.
